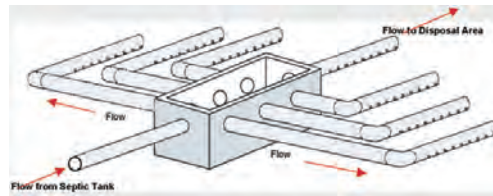

In New Jersey, a septic system which relies on gravity to move wastewater from the tank to the absorption area is required to use a **Distribution Box (D-box)**, which evenly distributes waste-water to all Trenches or throughout a Disposal Bed. Older D-boxes are made of concrete and newer ones can be made of concrete or polyethylene. When uncovered, concrete D-boxes are often found to show varying degrees of deterioration and are sometimes decayed enough to allow wastewater leakage into the underlying and surrounding soil. If left alone, bad D-boxes continue to crumble and may collapse inward, presenting a serious blockage problem.

New Jersey Septic Management Group can replace a damaged D-box, re-connecting it to existing lateral pipe sections and setting it to ensure proper distribution of septic effluent.
