Septic system delivery and drainage pipe sections often show a build-up of sewage sludge, lint and grease that will partially or totally obstruct



wastewater flow. Pipes can also get blocked when people flush cigarette butts, feminine hygiene products, paper towels and other materials that don't break down easily, into the septic tank and these items can flow out of the tank into drainage components. **New Jersey Septic Management Group** can use a Jet-Washer to remove that kind of debris and improve flow.

The process starts by feeding the high pressure, rotary Jetter into the delivery pipe from the outlet baffle of the septic tank or into the laterals through the distribution box. As it is fed into the pipe section, it breaks up the solids and loosens stuck materials and because it is spinning, it will negotiate turns in pipes. When the Jetter is pulled back out, it flushes the debris back into the tank or distribution box. The best time to jet-wash your system is when the tank is pumped, so the additional solids can be removed.
